ChangeNOW Unveils Full Program for 2024, accelerating ecological & social transition

Paris, Monday March 4th — 3 weeks from now, ChangeNOW, the key actor and facilitator of the ecological and social transition, is set to host ChangeNOW 2024, the largest event of solutions for the planet. Driven by a deep dedication to concrete action, the event will convene 35,000 participants including entrepreneurs, investors, change leaders, policymakers, media and citizens to deliver tangible solutions for both societal and business advancements.

Santiago Lefebvre, President and Founder of ChangeNOW, underscores the urgency of the moment, stating "This year, ChangeNOW lands at a critical moment: right after COP28 and mid-way through the UN's Sustainable Development Goals. We've shaped the event to deliver a comprehensive array of content that is more than ever at the forefront of current issues: from reshaping our economy to sustainable industrialization, touching on deep-sea mining, biodiversity, inclusion, etc. Over three days, we'll be uniting change leaders, pioneers, and innovators to foster collaboration and actionable steps, aiming to make a significant impact".

Key Themes Covering Ecological & Social Transition

Adapting to climate change

Adaptation to climate change emerges as humanity's challenge for the future years. Heatwaves coupled with intense droughts and devastating wildfires, sudden and uncontrollable floods are harbingers of what will become tomorrow's norm. From examining how cities, coastal residents, and citizens can adjust to climate change, to delving into the human dimension of climate change, with a specific emphasis on adaptation as a solution, we will explore how to rise to the challenges associated with adapting to climate change.

A standout feature in the program:

ChangeNOW 2024 will welcome **30 mayors from cities worldwide**, including Brussels, Lyon, Antwerp, Essen, Biarritz, Reykjavik, Turku, Charleroi, Vantaa, and Mannheim, as part of the **Sustainable Cities Program**. They will convene to exchange insights on urban resilience and the circular economy while connecting with the startup ecosystem to devise tailored sustainable solutions for their municipalities. Accompanied by **Sandrine Dixson-Declève**, Co-President of the Club of Rome, and representatives from **the Smart Cities Marketplace and the European Commission**, these leaders aim to amplify their impact on shaping sustainable urban futures.

Refunite, using technology to help separated individuals reconnect, especially in crisis or conflict situations; **Solicaz**, specialized in the preservation and restoration of the natural capital of soils; **Humanitarian OpenStreetMap**, dedicated to humanitarian action and community development through open mapping; **Smart cities marketplace**, revolutionizing energy transition & collaboration in European cities; **Oneka**, dedicated to delivering wave-powered desalination solutions to coastal communities and industries facing water scarcity

Sustainable Agriculture, healthy soils and food

Agriculture takes the spotlight as a crucial battleground for addressing both climate change and biodiversity loss while adapting to rising demand due to population growth and the need to rethink our diets. The agricultural and forestry sectors, significant contributors to greenhouse gas emissions and vulnerable to climate risks, are at a pivotal moment. Ensuring the resilience of production systems and ecosystems is a top concern for the coming decades. In tackling this major challenge, **our focus will be on regenerative agriculture as a practical solution to not just meet the increasing global demand for food but also to produce food that's healthy and respectful of our planet's resources.**

Standout features in the program:

- ChangeNOW will host the COP15 Desertification Presidency event, uniting solutions, funding, and international diplomatic support in the fight against desertification. The experience promises engagement in conferences on Institutional Power & Innovation for Biodiversity and exploration of avant-garde solutions through research and innovation. The unveiling of COP15's Desertification fresco serves to heighten awareness. Moreover, the event provides a platform for collaboration, bringing together stakeholders to foster connections and drive impactful projects.
- Attendees will have the unique opportunity to witness **the exclusive European premiere of "Common Ground"** the highly anticipated sequel to the documentary powerhouse, "Kiss the

Ground," celebrated by over 1 billion viewers worldwide. "Common Ground" navigates the complex nexus of money, power, and politics that influences our imperfect food system, seamlessly merging investigative journalism with compelling narratives from leaders in the food movement. As a special offering, admission is free.

Transforming the economy

The dynamic landscape of EU sustainability regulations is undergoing rapid changes, introducing substantial complexities spanning carbon issues, CSRD, new governance models and strategies for financing the transition. In this theme, we will delve into the transformation of corporations, explore the adoption of transparency, traceability, and innovative financing approaches, while also influencing change within industries.

Standout features in the program:

A highlight for this year is the **CDP Awards Europe 2024**, themed "MOVE THE MONEY", scheduled for Tuesday, March 26th at ChangeNOW.

High-level representatives from corporations, financial institutions, and governments will convene for pivotal discussions on funding the green transition, acting as a catalyst for global change. Highlights will be broadcast on Euronews TV.

- Energy: From the need to reduce energy needs to decarbonization and the challenge of making clean energy accessible globally.
- **Biodiversity:** Raising awareness about the importance of preserving and restoring biodiversity and studying the challenges to achieve it.
- Water and ocean: Addressing issues related to deep-sea mining and exploring ways to
 preserve and restore underwater biodiversity, examining water cycles, and making this
 essential resource accessible to all.
- Inclusion, without which the ecological and social transition cannot succeed.

OFFICIAL CHANGENOW SELECTION OF SOLUTIONS

The 2024 ChangeNOW Official Selection of Solutions boasts an impressive array of **1000 solutions**, with **300 participating in exhibitions and 200 in pitching sessions**, across 15 different themes.

Here are some key statistics for this year's exhibition and pitch of solutions:

- Representing 47 nations, the diversity spans across Europe, North America, Africa, Asia, Central, and South America.
- Nearly half of the solutions are expanding internationally, a quarter are focused on domestic growth, and the remaining quarter are acquiring their first customers. The selection also includes a limited panel of solutions in the prototype stage.
- The 2024 ChangeNOW Official Selection covers various development stages and funding models, including Grant, Seed Equity, Serie C, Serie A, Serie B.
- The total funding sought for both Expo and Pitch participants is 1.5 Billion Euros.

FOSTERING INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS

ChangeNOW 2024 will welcome representatives from 120 countries, including Singapore, Taiwan, Japan, South Korea, Brazil, South Africa, Québec, Luxembourg, Belgium, The Hague, Ukraine, Rwanda, and more.

PIONEERING SUSTAINABLE EVENTS

ChangeNOW proudly stands as the first major event accredited at Level 2 by Reeve, one of the most holistic label for sustainable events. Our overarching objective is to transform events into powerful amplifiers of positive impact for the planet. Among our commitments this year:

- Targeting Zero Waste with zero goodies, kakemonos, carpet, plastic bottles, disposable food or packaging, or by achieving 97.3% reuse of materials in scenography and signage.
- Sustainable Food Practices: Ensuring a minimum of 75% vegetarian meals to promote sustainable and mindful consumption.
- Reducing Carbon Footprint: Implementing comprehensive carbon footprint measurement and offsetting 100% of the calculated footprint, in partnership with ClimateSeed. Additionally, fostering partnerships with European rail companies to encourage train travel over air travel.
